Enrollment Process

The following information is needed for each student at the time of enrollment

- Completed Student Registration Application Packet*
- Original Birth Certificate*
- Parent/legal guardian driver license or state identification*
- Copy of most recent report card / copy of most recent IEP if applicable*
- Current Immunization Record*
- Health Appraisal Form (to be completed by physician)*
- Vision screening for kindergarten applicants*

Michigan Law (Public Health Code, Act 368, and Michigan School Code, Act 291) requires a vision screening for kindergarten entrance. Vision screening done by a health department technician, a physician, or an eye doctor fulfills this requirement. Oakland County Health Division offers free vision screening for County residents.
